

**SUBJECT: Application of Rates**

**POLICY: Application of Rates**

**PROCEDURE:**

**I. Application of Rates:**

- A. The rate schedules of the Board of Light & Power (BLP) are predicated upon delivery of each class of service to a single metering point for the total requirements of each separate premises of the customer. Service at different points and at different premises shall be separately measured and separately billed.
- B. In some cases the customer is eligible to take service under more than one rate. Upon request, the BLP will advise the customer in the selection of the rate which will provide the lowest cost of service, based on the information provided to the BLP, but the responsibility for the selection of the rate and any desired changes in the future lies with the customer.
- C. After the customer has selected the desired rate under which he elects to take service, the customer will not be permitted to change from that rate to another rate until at least twelve months have elapsed.
- D. No refund will be made of the difference in charges under different rates applicable to the same class of service.
