



Transmission Line Upgrade Project

The Grand Haven Board of Light and Power is undertaking Phase III of its major transmission system upgrade this year. Transmission System Interconnections are important because they provide improved reliability, help to lower costs to our customers, and improve the BLP's connection to the regional transmission grid.

This is the final phase of a three phased system upgrade project. Phase I was completed in 2017 in Grand Haven along Ferry Street and Phase II was completed in 2018 along Coho Drive and US31. This project will start at Van Wagoner and US31 and will end at our substation on Sternberg Rd just East of Brooks Rd. This project will be a complete rebuild, including larger poles, wire and insulators. The engineering and survey work is complete and we will be transitioning into the construction phase soon. Our goal is to have the line completely rebuilt before the warm weather hits in 2019.
