2021 Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report

This annual fugitive dust control report has been developed to describe the actions taken by Grand Haven Board of Light & Power (GHBLP) personnel or contractors to control CCR Fugitive dust, a record of citizen complaints and a summary of any corrective actions taken. As of April 2020, the facility had been taken control by Bierlein Companies Inc. (Bierlein) who was a demolition company in charge of demolishing the J.B. Sims Generating Station. While demolition took place Bierlein routinely sprayed water in areas where loose, dry CCR material was present by means of water trucks, mist machines and/or fire hosing. At the beginning of August 2021, Bierlein equipment was demobilized off site and the demolition project completed. At this time, the property control reverted to Grand Haven Board of Light & Power.
