



POWER SUPPLY COST ADJUSTMENT (PSCA) -

increases or decreases to recover actual costs of wholesale power above or below the base cost for these expenses. The Board set the PSCA to zero for FY2021 to accommodate its transition from generating most of its power at Sims to purchasing all its power through Michigan Public Power Agency. The Board will reinstate the PSCA in September 2022.
