Net Metering Timeline

- 1. Customer decides they want to investigate owning generation and talks to the Utility.
- 2. Utility provides Customer with Application for Interconnection
- 3. When Customer is ready to move forward, they complete the application and pay the fee of \$100.
- 4. Utility reviews the application, performs analysis/study of the impact of the generation on the system, and informs the customer of any special requirements that have to be included in the interconnection (ie. Disconnect, relay scheme, etc.)
- 5. Customer applies for Net Metering treatment.
- 6. Utility reviews number of Customers in Net Metering Program and decides whether the Customer will be accepted.
- 7. Customer installs equipment.
- 8. Inspection of interconnection equipment by Utility representative for completeness and adherence to required standards.
- 9. Customer and Utility execute Interconnection Operating Agreement.
- 10. Customer and Utility execute Net Metering Agreement.
- 11. Customer completes interconnection
