In early 2025, we celebrated the launch of the Brandt Woods Solar project. Now, we're excited to share that our second solar project of the year — White Tail Solar — officially went online at the end of 2025.

About White Tail Solar

- Located in Washtenaw County
- Partnership with 13 public power utilities
- Provides 2.15 megawatts of solar energy to BLP
- Generates about 3,700 megawatt-hours per year
- Powers approximately 520 homes annually
